

Subject: Sources Sought for Architectural & Engineering Services

Greetings:

Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS), a prime contract to the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), is actively seeking sources for architectural and engineering (A&E) services at Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). THIS IS NOT A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL OR SOLICITATION.

The majority of the work at LANL is ultimately considered to be R&D in nature. Therefore, the A&E Services may include, but are not limited to, engineering studies, preliminary planning, conceptual designs, final designs, construction inspections, engineering reviews, submittal reviews, design build performance specifications, cost estimating, process system design, nuclear analysis, and system design, lightning protection design, seismic analysis, instrumentation and controls design, safety analysis, R&D equipment installations, and environmental studies.

It is anticipated that this procurement action will be a partial small business set-aside with multiple awards under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code 541712, "Research and Development in the Physical, Engineering, and Life Sciences".
