

Five companies received funding through new venture acceleration fund

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In an effort to support regional Native American economic development, the Lab; Los Alamos National Security, LLC; the Regional Development Corporation and New Mexico Indian Affairs Department made their first venture acceleration awards to tribal organizations.

Applications for the awards, worth up to \$30,000 each, were solicited from the following tribes: Nambe, Ohkay Owingeh, Picuris, Santa Clara, Pojoaque, Taos, San Ildefonso, Tesuque, Cochiti and Jemez. Eligible companies had to be for profit and be owned at least 51 percent by a tribe or tribal member.

The application included information on how the funds would be used to increase revenues. Twelve companies submitted proposals and those receiving funding included: San Ildefonso Development Corp., Three Eagles Development Corp., Cochiti Pueblo Development Corp., Sunbeam Indian Art and Avanyu Constructions Services, LLC.
