Deadline for Regional College/Returning Student Scholarships is June 17 Students who had to interrupt their formal education due to military service, family needs or other reasons may qualify for the Los Alamos National Laboratory Foundation's Regional College/Returning Student Scholarship. The scholarships are one-year grants of \$1,000 and applicants can reapply yearly while they complete a two-year degree or certification at an accredited regional college. The deadline for the applications is Monday, June 17.

The scholarship is intended to support those who are ready to expand their career opportunities. Applicants must be a resident in one of Northern New Mexico's seven counties (Los Alamos, Mora, Rio Arriba, San Miguel, Sandoval, Santa Fe and Taos) and they must be accepted into a degree or certification program at an accredited college or are already pursuing such education.
