Among others, the following directives of likely interest to readers were added to the contract on June 11:

- DOE-STD-1189-08, Integration of Safety into the Design Process
- DOE O 430.2B, Departmental Energy, Renewable Energy, and Transportation Management
- DOE O 430.1B Chg 1, Real Property Asset Management

ESM Chapters 1 and 14 were revised to reflect these on June 16.

IHS ONLINE NATIONAL STANDARDS

Discussed at length last month, IHS, LANL's online national standards provider, has introduced a product revision called "IHS Standards Expert." This new interface delivers the same results as "Specs & Standards" but has a more intuitive design and an enhanced set of administrative tools.

COE PROCEDURE CHANGES

The following Conduct of Engineering institutional Administrative Procedures were approved in June:

- AP-341-516, R0 Operability Determination and Functionality Assessment
- AP-341-613, R0 Instrumentation Set Point Control

LANL STANDARDS ISSUED IN JUNE

ENGINEERING STANDARD MANUAL

Chapter 1 Section Z10 General Requirements for all Disciplines, R6, 6/16/08

Added DOE-STD-1189. Clarified subsections on State code (including clear adoption of IBC-2008), NCR, and Code of Record including engineering during construction requirement. MDL harmonized to AP-341-403, MEL per AP-341-404. New section on Environmental Management. Temporary Facilities redefined. Minor changes to Appendices A, C, and D.

Chapter 1 Section 200, Equipment Numbering and Labeling R7, 6/16/08

Clarified existing facility use, added CLI term, addressed sequence number reuse, other minor clarifications.

Chapter 2 Fire Protection, R3, 6/18/08

Added IFC, NM IBC amendments, most stringent concept. Protection loss threshold was \$1M. Occupancy analysis for IBC and NFPA. Added 420.1-3, deleted STD-1062. Other minor changes.

Chapter 5 Structural Section II (PC-0, PC-1, and PC-2 Design and Analysis Requirements), R5, 6/16/08

Several minor revisions to align with IBC-2006 changes and reference DOE-STD-1189. App A concrete anchor requirements revised slightly (still conservative versus IBC).

Chapter 7 Electrical Section D5000, R3, 6/6/08

Requirements for coordination studies for special electrical systems expanded. Added requirement for documented analysis to support decisions to modify existing major electrical equipment. Added UPS and engine-generator load summaries on one-line diagram sheets. Provisions for future expansion of electrical systems clarified. Aligned arc-flash warning label requirements with LANL ISD 101-13. Requirements for marking working spaces modified. Added graded approach

to determine the extent of formal electrical acceptance testing.

Chapter 13 Welding & Joining

Volume 1 General Welding Standards

Several GWSs were revised 6/6/08 to address audit corrective actions and minor changes to clarify intent or requirements with biggest changes the addition of written practice for welding NDE qualifications:

- 1-02, Administrative Control of Welding & Brazing, r5 and new Att 4
- 1-03, Welding & Brazing Material Procurement & Control, r4
- 1-05, Welder Performance Qualification & Certification, r3
- 1-10, Training, r4 and Att 2 revised
- 1-11, Inspector Qualification Visual and NDE, r3 and revised Att 1 and 2; new Att 3

Chapter 14 Sustainable Design, R5, 6/16/08

Revisions to requirements to implement DOE O 430.2B (e.g., LEED Gold, Energy Star, Labs 21)
