A Google-based search feature has also been added, but use care -- it also returns historical documents, especially specs. Once you find the document you think you want, it's best to re-access it by drilling in from homepage.

### SUSTAINABLE DESIGN MAKES LEAP FORWARD AT LANL

The month of May saw major advances in LANL's commitment to the environment. In addition to the Environmental Management System training everyone's doing as part of LANL's ISO 14001 certification, every LANL division is working on an Environmental Action Plan for energy efficiency and pollution prevention. The Standards Program is doing its part, too. There's now a new Sustainable Design Chapter 14 of the Engineering Standards. Among other things, it will ensure that future line item buildings are LEED Certified. A Sustainable Design Technical Committee was also formed to support the chapter.

LEED is the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Green Building Rating System, a voluntary, consensus-based national standard for developing high-performance, sustainable buildings.

In addition, Rene Holaday in the ENG-DECS I&C/Commissioning Team has achieved certification as a LEED Accredited Professional (AP).

The difficult certification exam ensures the AP has the knowledge and skills necessary to participate in the design process, to support and encourage integrated design, and to streamline the application and certification process -- plus understanding of green building practices and principles, and familiarity with LEED requirements, resources, and processes. When a building project is going for LEED certification and an AP is involved in a project, then the project obtains an additional point toward LEED Certification.

ENG-DECS now has two LEED APs, the other being Michael Ladach; both are available for consultation on LANL building projects.
