- AP-341-503, Engineered Equivalent Determination: Revised FM02, , Page 3 of 3, Section 5.0 Reviews and Approvals. Added the following for Additional Review: QEV Review For nuclear facilities, engineered equivalent determination shall be reviewed by a LANL Qualified Evaluator.
- AP-341-703, Item Dedication: Revised FM01, Attachment 1, Form Instructions, Section 2.0 Item Dedication, Method 1, Special Tests and Inspections. Added after the first sentence, "The individual(s) (RE or the receipt inspection personnel) must be qualified inspectors to perform these inspections."
